WRL's and James City County's renovation of the Children's Library resulted in the Kiwanis Kids Idea Studio. The Idea Studio is a bright, airy, family friendly space with reading nooks, multi-media stations and science exhibits bringing STEAM concepts to life.

Kiwanis Care Closets are located in Williamsburg/James County schools, Care Closets are stocked with snacks, clothing, and personal hygiene products for students in need.
